**Nuclear New Build at Wylfa? Is it needed in Wales and are there better alternatives?**

Date: Friday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2010

The UK Government has announced its desire to develop a new generation of nuclear power stations. The only site nominated in Wales is at Wylfa in Anglesey. No reactors will be built in Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Should Wylfa B be a part of the future energy mix in Wales? Are there better energy alternatives in Anglesey and North Wales? Should the Welsh Assembly Government oppose the building of Wylfa B and continue to call for a public inquiry? Does nuclear new build bring jobs to Wales or can other energy sources provide more jobs and be a more sustainable and waste free alternative? And what are those alternatives in Wales?

This FREE seminar has been organised by the Nuclear Free Local Authorities Welsh Forum to allow councillors and officers in Welsh councils to hear an alternative view on nuclear power than that being provided by the prospective owner of the Wylfa reactor, Horizon. It is open to all interested councillors, officers, interested citizen groups and the general public across Wales and the South West.
