The seminar is a free event open to all interested in the impact of new nuclear and waste on Wales, and what alternative energy solutions exist.

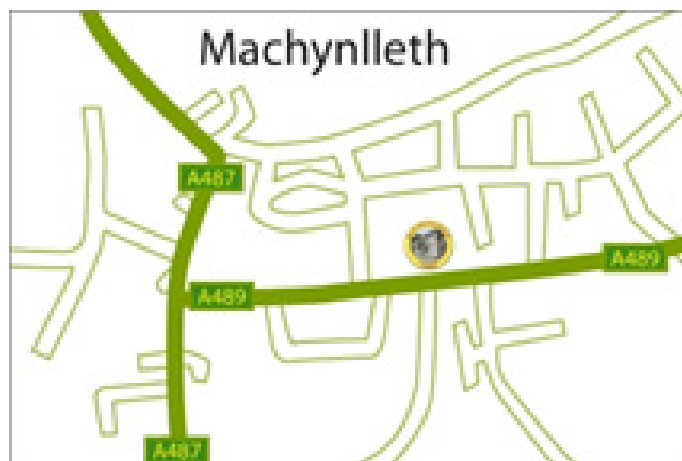
