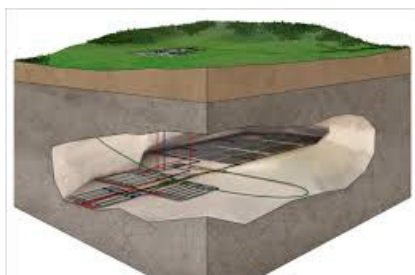

### **Venue and local details:**

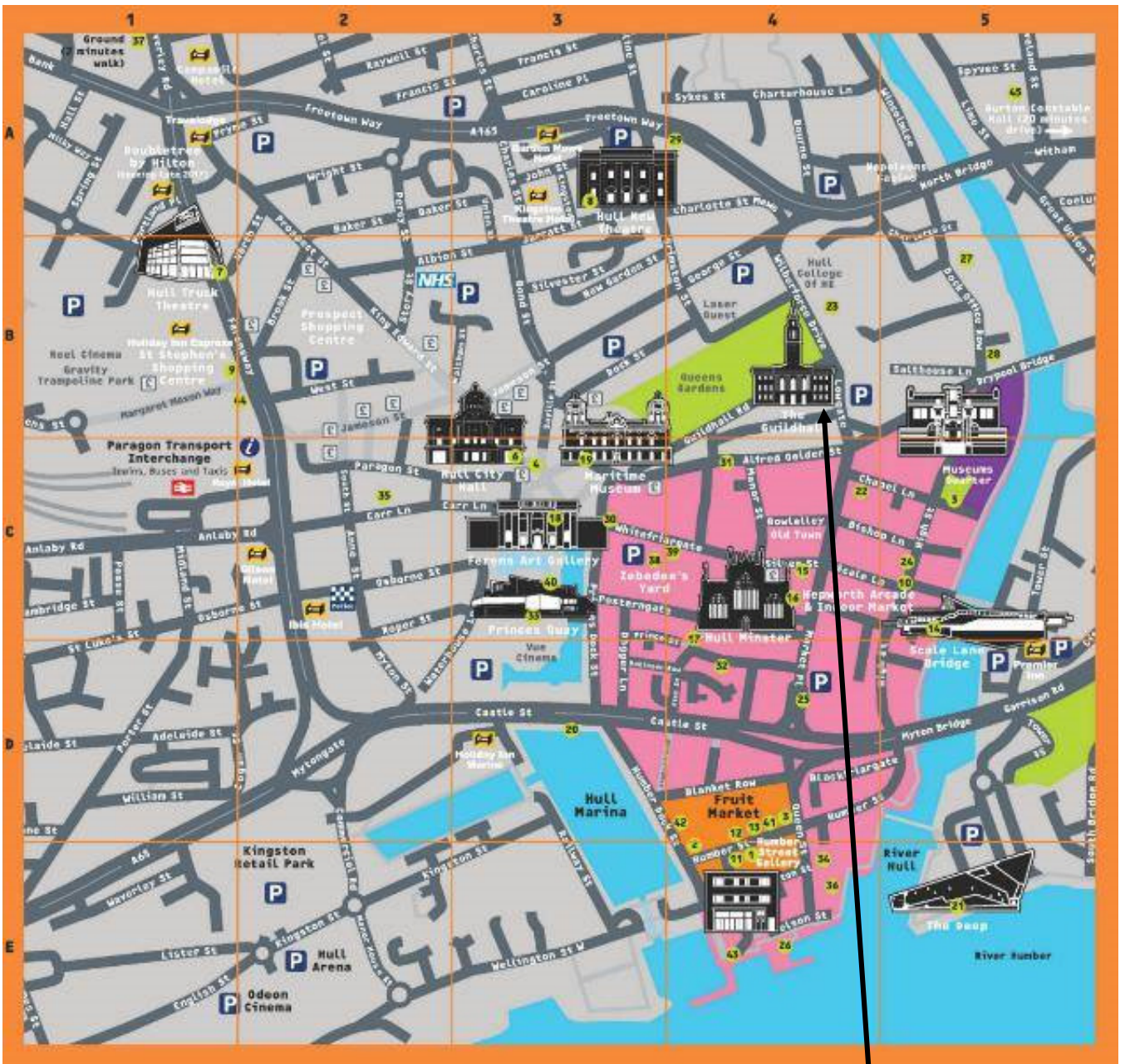
